NOTICE to be given to a Boy at the time of his offering to join the Royal Air Force.

Date. 19<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 1956

The General Conditions of the Contract of Enlistment that you are about to enter into with the Crown are as follows :—

1. You will engage to serve Her Majesty as an airman for a period of Regular Air Force Service, terminating on the expiration of twelve years from the date on which you attain the age of 18 years, provided Her Majesty so long requires your services, and with the additional liabilities specified in Question 22 on page 3 of this Form. Airmen who reach the required standard may be accepted for re-engagement with a view to pension.

2. On enlistment into the Royal Air Force, you will be liable, if medically fit, to carry out duty in the air in any type of aircraft and may be ordered to serve in any part of the world, ashore or afloat.

3. Your term of Service will be reckoned thus :—

The service shall begin to reckon from the date on which you attain the age of eighteen years, but if you are guilty of any of the following offences :

- (a) Desertion from Her Majesty's Service ; or
- (b) Fraudulent enlistment ;

the whole period of service prior to disposal of offence shall be forfeited.

4. The age given by you on enlistment will be accepted as your true age, and you will be liable to be held to serve on the engagement for which you attest notwithstanding that at some future date you may prove that your age given on enlistment is incorrect.

5. If serving beyond the seas at the time you are due for your discharge you will be sent to the United Kingdom free of expense, subject to the conditions of Question 22 (b) on page 3 of this notice.

6. You will be attested by the Attesting Officer. On signing the attestation paper and taking the oath you will be subject to all the provisions of the Air Force Act for the time being in force.

7. If within three months of your enlistment you pay for the use of Her Majesty a sum not exceeding £20 you can be discharged, unless when you claim such discharge a Proclamation is in force requiring the Air Force Reserve to enter upon Regular Service.

8. You will be required by the Attesting Officer to answer the questions printed on pages 2, 3 and 4, and to take the oath shown on page 4, and you are warned that if you wilfully or knowingly make at the time of your attestation any false answer to him you will thereby render yourself liable under the Air Force Act to punishment.
